Oska Bright Award 2005 - Best Overall Film

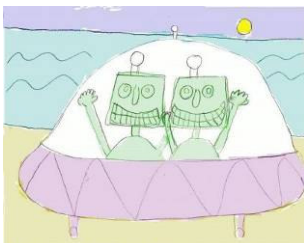
Cooking With Matthew by Matthew Hellett (Hove)
