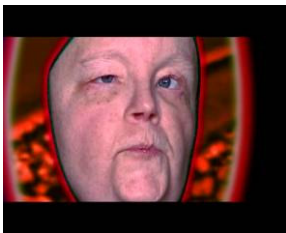
The Raven's Tale by The Shystershadows (Coventry)
