A film-within-a-film about how a disabled woman's life and work change after she suffers a miscarriage.

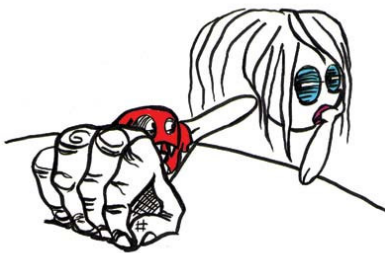

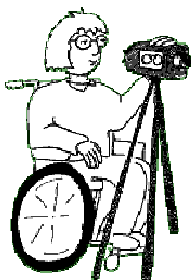
